



## Year 5 Home Learning

### Daily Tasks:

#### Reading

At least 30 minutes, preferably to an adult. Questioning your child's understanding of what they have read would be helpful.

#### Times tables

Children should log into their account at <https://trockstars.com/>.

#### Writing

Diary: daily diary entry in their exercise book. This could include activities, thoughts and feelings. This may help children to process what is happening and be an interesting record to look back on in future days.

#### Exercise
