



## Home Learning

In the event that your child is at home for any length of time either due to self-isolation or school closure, we wanted to set out our expectations for home learning. This will include daily expectations, research projects and links to online resources.

### Daily Tasks

1. **Reading:** at least 30 minutes, preferably to an adult. Questioning your child's understanding of what they have read would be helpful.
2. **Times tables:** children should regularly log into their account at <https://trockstars.com/>.
3. **Writing:** daily diary entry in their exercise book. This could include activities, thoughts and feelings. This may help children to process what is happening and be an interesting record to look back on in future days.
4. **CGP Books:** Continue to work through all your CGP books, revising anything you are unsure of and complete as many pages as you can.
5. **Purplemash:** Log into your Purplemash account at <https://www.purplemash.com/#tab/pm-home>.
